19 Policy

1. Online bookings and payment only.

Students/parents are to pay for the full course online via BACS or PayPal before attending classes along with the contact and medical forms also to be signed and returned online via email.

2. All students must sign the Covid - 19 policy.

The Covid-19 policy for classes is available on our website and sent out via email for students to sign and return. Students will not be able to attend classes without doing this.

Parents are responsible for explaining the policy thoroughly to

children before attending classes.

3. Students must not attend class if they or someone they have been in contact with have shown signs of Covid - 19.

If you have experienced or been in contact with anyone who has shown symptoms of Covid-19 please contact your instructor asap to notify that you will not be attending the class. The instructor will also send students home if they turn up to class showing obvious signs of Covid-19. You will be able to attend again once you have taken a Covid-19 test and the result is negative. There will be no refund available for any missed classes by students due to limited spaces.

Symptoms:

- High temperature
- New, continuous cough
- Loss of, change to, your sense of smell or taste

4. All students must social distance on arrival, departure and during all classes.

Weston students: When arriving students are to wait on the left hand side of the main doors to the building 2m apart and wait to be collected by the Instructor five minutes before their class starts. children are to be supervised by an adult whilst waiting to enter but

no adults/parents are to enter the building unless they have a reason to do so and have agreed with the instructor.

When waiting to collect a child adults/parents are to wait 2m apart on the right hand side of the main doors of the building. Parents are not to enter the building to collect unless they have reason to do so and have agreed with the instructor.

All students will be chaperoned out of the building by their instructor to ensure 2m distance is in place.

Stroud students: When arriving students are to wait 2m apart at the top of the car park by the railings (Signs will be displayed) and wait to be collected by their instructor five minutes before their class starts. Children are to be supervised by an adult whilst waiting to enter but no adults/parents are to enter the building unless they have reason to do so and have agreed with the instructor.

When waiting to collect a child adults/parents are to wait 2m apart at the end of the car park (signs will be displayed). Parents are not to enter the building to collect unless they have reason to do so and have agreed with the instructor.

All students will be chaperoned out of the building by their instructor to ensure 2m distance is in place.

5. All students must arrive ready for class.

To limit the use of using other areas of the building students are to come ready for class. When arriving students will be told one at a time to put belongings in the designated area before going to their own station. Students are to bring their drink and anything else they may need throughout the class to their station with them.

6. Students will not need masks during classes.

Masks are not needed during exercise or if students are under the age of 11. Doors and windows will be open to help ventilation.

7. All students must sanitize hands when entering or leaving the Studio or if asked to do so throughout the class.

Hand sanitizer will be available by the studio door.

8. Only two people per equipment and all students to stay in their own designated station at all times.

Classes have been reduced to ensure social distance is in place and only two students per equipment as well as the instructor when demonstrating. Stations will be marked out for students to stay in throughout the class. Stations will be 2m apart from each other and equipment. Each station will have blue roll, cleaning bottle and wipes.

9. All students are responsible for cleaning down all of the equipment thoroughly between each user.

Blue roll and a cleaning bottle will be provided in each students station. Cleaning demonstration will be provided at the beginning of the class to ensure the equipment is cleaned down properly.

10. All students and instructor are responsible for wiping down the toilet if used.

Wipes will be provided to do this.

11. Students are to bring their own water bottles to classes and are not to use studio cultery.

12. 15 minutes in between classes for deep cleaning and so social distancing can be adhered to.

Equipment, door handles, toilets, cleaning equiment will be all thoroughly cleaned before, inbetween and after each class.
